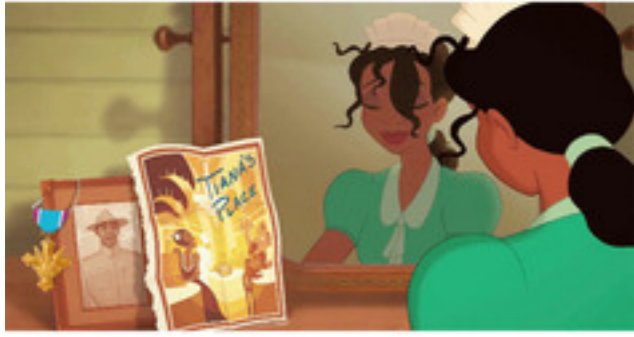


Read through the five savings tips. Choose one of the tips and create a poster or meme about saving.

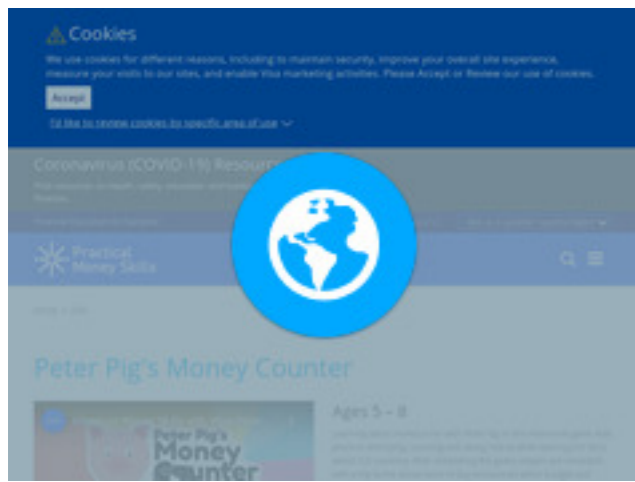


Open Ended Question
